

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Hangin' Judge Spring Livestock Show

April 26, 2008
Fort Smith, Arkansas

General Rules

1. This show is open to all 4-H and FFA members nationwide and is conducted under the auspices of the Arkansas-Oklahoma State Fair.
2. Exhibitors may enter as many animals as they wish in the following:
Prospect Steers (No weight limit - broken by weigh & breed.)
Registered Beef Heifers
Commercial Heifers
3. Interpretations of show rules will be made by the show committee and their decision will be final.
4. All exhibitors must be completely responsible for the care and exhibiting of their own animals. The Show Committee shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibitor's property.
5. Entry fees per animal are as follows:
All Beef Animals - \$25.00 per animal
6. Entry forms, accompanied by entry fees, are due by April 11th without a late fee. Entry fees will be refunded.
7. An additional Late Entry Fee will be charged after April 11th until the time of check-in for division. The late fee is \$10 per animal.
8. All exhibitors must furnish their own feed and bedding. No Straw bedding allowed. Shavings will be available for purchase on grounds.
9. There will be no release time. Exhibitors may leave after showing.
10. Stalls will be available in barn #1.
11. Premiums will be paid on 4 places. Ribbons will be given through 7th place.
12. Grooming chutes and generators will not be allowed in the barns.
13. Arkansas Health Requirements will apply. Health papers will be checked.
14. Any artificial filling of any kind, by any means, water drenched or air included will automatically result in disqualification.

Heifer Rules

1. Entries will be open to heifers born after April 1, 200
2. The registration certificate or proof of ownership, must be presented at check-in and must show exhibitor as the owner.
3. There must be 5 animals per breed in order for them to show as a separate breed; otherwise, they will be shown as A.O.B.'s.
4. There will be Commercial Heifer classes, shown by weight and breed influences.

Steer Rules

1. All steers must have baby teeth present. Will be subject to mouthing.
2. Steers will be shown in the following breeds: A.O.B. (A.O.B.'s will be divided into continental or Brahman breeds) Charolais, Chianina, Limousin, Maine-Anjou, Simmental, Angus, Hereford/Polled Hereford and Shorthorn steers will be shown in these breeds provided there are 5 entries; otherwise, they will be shown as A.O.B.'s.
3. Classes will be formed according to the official show weight of each steer. Equal number of steers will be put into classes whenever possible.
4. There will be a 30 pound weigh back on steers after placing in a class.
